



I'm proud to announce that starting on July 15th, families in Ohio's Third Congressional District are eligible to receive monthly payments of up to \$300 per child through the enhanced Child Tax Credit.

I fought hard to include the enhanced Child Tax Credit in the American Rescue Plan because it will help set America's children up for success and put more money in the pockets of hardworking parents. 91.3% of children in the Third Congressional District will benefit economically from the enhanced Child Tax Credit, and 53,000 households will see an average total benefit of \$3,300. Whether it is to pay for childcare or put gas in the car, the expanded Child Tax Credit will help fuel our economy while building better lives for the families.

In order to receive the full financial support they are entitled to, families must file a 2021 tax return, no matter their circumstances. Furthermore, taxpayers will qualify for the full credit if their income is below \$75,000 for single filers, \$112,000 for head of household, or \$150,000 for joint filers. To be eligible, children must: have a Social Security number, reside with the individual claiming them for at least half of the year, and be under 18-years-old as of December 31, 2021. Biological children, adopted children, stepchildren, half-siblings, foster children, grandchildren, nieces or nephews, and certain other relatives are eligible. In addition, the adult filing taxes must possess a Social Security Number or an Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN).
